Employement Statistics 2019 - Master of Science Graduates

In 2017 341 students (229 Italian and 112 international) obtained the Master's degree in Architecture And Urban Design. Total respondents to the annual employment survey were 233 (coverage rate 68%).

Graduates' Profile: 65% female and 35% male; average age of graduation: 26.5 years; average duration of studies 2,4 years; average graduation marks: 106,6/110; 84% carried out an internship during their studies.






